KDU Excels in Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Ranking Tables 2022

The Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Rankings are the only global performance Tables that assess universities in terms of achieving the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The most recent edition includes 1,524 universities from 110 countries and regions spread across 18 Tables — one for each of the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), plus one overall ranking. The rankings show the impact across all 17 SDGs based on a series of more than 100 metrics and over 200 measurements covering universities' teaching, research, community outreach and stewardship of their own resources.

KDU first entered THE Impact Ranking Tables in 2022, and its remarkable success exemplifies the university's dedication and commitment to providing high-quality higher education in Sri Lanka to reach international standards.

KDU was ranked 2nd in Sri Lanka for the Quality of Education in The Times Higher Education Impact Rankings.

In terms of overall ranking, KDU is placed 4th in the country and 801 – 1000 globally. KDU's ranking in SDG 4 (quality education) reflects KDU's contribution to improving student facilities by investing in new infrastructure, establishing state-of-the-art laboratories, initiating the establishment of smart classrooms and the provision of distance learning facilities, providing free laptops to students during their early years, and providing free Wi-Fi access, food/ accommodation facilities, and a variety of other benefits.

Further, it is an acclamation of KDU's belief that education is a vital means of overcoming inequalities and KDU's commitment for realizing the same through the introduction of new and innovative programmes of study, thereby expanding opportunities for higher education for students

IQSSL Accreditation – BSc (Hons) Quantity Surveying Degree, Faculty of Built Environment & Spatial Sciences

The Department of Quantity Surveying (QS), Faculty of Built Environment and Spatial Sciences of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University has been relentlessly working to secure the Institute of Quantity Surveyors Sri Lanka (IQSSL) accreditation for its Bachelor of Science (Hons) Degree in QS.IQSSL is the sole recognized QS professional body in Sri Lanka administering the standards for degree programmes in QS.

The (Hons) Degree in QS was granted the conditional accreditation by IQSSL by reference IQSSL/COUNCIL/01/2022/0929, dated 16th June 2022. This is a great achievement in the history of the Faculty, as this is the first professional recognition to be obtained for one of its degree programmes.



The entire Department and its academia, led by the Head of the Department, has been striving hard throughout the year to secure this goal. The Faculty wishes to convey its sincere thanks to the dignitaries of IQSSL including its President, Vice President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary and the Council Members. With the IQSSL recognition, the BSc (Hons) Quantity Surveying graduates of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University will be recognized worldwide and among all, they shall be leading employers/stakeholders in the field of construction with higher perks and due professional status.

The newly established Faculty is the 11th faculty in KDU, which is fast becoming a leading seat of higher education in the country.

Gunaratne said that the need to establish such a faculty was initially asserted by the then President Gotabaya Rajapaksa at the Security Council held on 19th October 2020, where he emphasized the value of creating a professional Police Force comprised of officers who are academically and professionally qualified with law and enforcement to serve the nation effectively. Subsequently, KDU was given the responsibility to create the necessary academic atmosphere and the KDU Board of Management approved the establishment of the proposed Faculty. He expressed confidence that the very outcome of this great step taken by KDU would immensely contribute to law enforcement and related systems by providing a community of well-acquainted professionals in the field of Criminal Justice to our motherland. During the ceremony, the Defence Secretary also launched the website of the new Faculty. The Vice Chancellor of KDU Major General Milinda Peiris presented a memento to the Defence Secretary as a token of appreciation during the ceremony.

Dean of the Faculty of Criminal Science Prof. Jeeva Niriella made the welcome address. Secretary to the Ministry of Public Security Major General K. Jagath Alwis, Inspector General of Police CD Wickramaratne, Director General of the INSS Prof. Rohan Gunaratna, senior police officers and members of the KDU academic and administrative staff were also present at the occasion.


High Commissioner of Canada to Sri Lanka Visits KDU

Legacy of General Sir John Lionel Kotelawala



General Sir John Lionel Kotelawala CH KBE KStJ PC born on 4th April 1897, was a Sri Lankan statesman, who served as the 3rd Prime Minister of Ceylon from 1953 to 1956. With the outbreak of the 2nd World War, Sir John Kotelawala, Minister of Communications and Works, became a member of Ceylon's War Council and was appointed as the Commander-in-Chief of the Essential Services Labor Corp. His home, at Kandawala estate in Ratmalana, had been provided by him to establish the Officers' Mess of Wartime British Royal Air Force.

In 1978, the commanders of the armed forces identified a need to establish a Defence academy to cater to the academic training of its officers. With the proposal of Lieutenant General Denis Perera, Commander of the Sri Lanka Army in 1979, Sir John Kotelawala agreed to donate the Kandawala estate to establish the institution, which later became General Sir John Kotalawala Defence University (KDU).

Maintaining the legacy of this towering icon of Sri Lankan political and military history, KDU bears legitimate ownership to preserve his Orders, Decorations, Medals and other memorabilia including the Cadillac, his car and his home, the Walawwa. The regalia are on display at the museum of the General Sir John Kotalawala Defence University.

Webinar on 'An Overview of Digital Foot Printing (Digital Forensics)'




'Information Literacy for Academic and Research Success'

Civil and Military Academic and Non-academic Inter-Faculty **Billiard Tournament**


